

CHILDREN'S ART PRESERVATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility: Each applicant must be a senior in good standing at Morrison High School. Applicants must be accepted at a vocational training program or institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate student. The course of study must be in the area of fine arts, with preference given to visual arts.

AWARD: up to a \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student based on their ability, involvement in support of visual arts, past achievements, goals and their sincerity of purpose in reaching his or her goal.

SELECTION: Completed applications (typed) are to be returned to the high school guidance counselor no later than March 15th of the applicant's senior year. These applications will be reviewed by a committee selected by the CAPA board. The scholarship will be awarded at Morrison High School at the annual Honor's Night.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP: This scholarship is intended to assist the recipient with the cost of tuition only. Therefore, it will be paid directly to the school on behalf of the recipient.
