accessible (adj)	able to <b>go</b> in to, enter, or approach
accessory (n)	an article or item worn with an outfit that " <b>goes with</b> " or matches the outfit
concede (v)	to <b>yield</b> to an opponent that one has lost; to give in; to admit that something is true and valid
exceed (v)	to <b>go</b> or be beyond the limit or expectations
intercede (v)	to mediate; to <b>go</b> between people to help them reach an agreement

precede (v)	to <b>go</b> before something else in time, order, place, or rank
proceed (v)	to keep on <b>going</b> ; to <b>go</b> ahead with something; to move along
recede (v)	to <b>go</b> or move back
recess (n)	the time during which people <b>go</b> out to take a break
successor (n)	a person who <b>goes</b> after someone else (usually related to a person taking over a job that is of higher rank)
