mandate (n)	an order or command placed in one's <b>hands</b>
maneuver (v)	to <b>handily</b> or skillfully go around something

manicure (n)	a treatment for the <b>hands</b> and nails
manipulate (v)	to skillfully operate by <b>hand</b>
manual (n)	a <b>handbook</b> ; a book of directions
manufacture (v)	to make by <b>hand</b> or by machine; to change raw material into a new product
manuscript (n)	a <b>handwritten</b> or typed piece of writing, such as a book
